Induction for Integration: Preparing for Training in Western Countries

A presentation for Postgraduate trainees, and some of the Heads of Schools was delivered by Dr. Krish T Radhakrishnan on 13th December 2019. The presentation was aimed to benefit the visitors to plan, support and better their experience during their stay in the western countries. The discussion covered pre-visit planning, cultural competencies, communication skills, motivation, resilience, leadership development, clinical governance, infection control, mandatory online training, reflective learning/writing, horizon scanning for opportunities and preventing being a learner in difficulties. The feedback was encouraging, and an annual delivery was requested by the participants.

Emerging Therapeutic Interventions and Novel Management Strategies in Cardiovascular Diseases
A lecture on the above topic was delivered by Dr. Ashan Gunarathne on the 19th of December 2019. This was organised in collaboration with the Kandy Society of Medicine (KSM) and catered to postgraduate trainees, general physicians, and cardiologists. The lecture was well attended, and the feedback was satisfactory.
